As President of the Artists' Guild for this year, I have seen many of our goals achieved and the Guild has thrived with acquiring many new members to reach the goal of **100 Members**. This number hadn't been achieved since the 1980s. It is good to feel we are a vital organization! We proposed this year and continued the traditional 4 shows a year (March, May-included judging and awards, July, Oct), held at least 2 workshops (June & Sept), participated in organized fieldtrips, continued "Plein Air Paint-outs" at different locations (Flag Ponds, Battle Creek Cypress Swamp, Warriors Rest), and encouraged larger attendance at meetings with informative & educational programs. We updated our web site, printed a tri-fold brochure, and published an outstanding Directory/ Roster. The new Board for 2007 will continue to offer programs and activities for artists. It is wonderful to have a week of just painting without the home distractions to get you motivated and re-vitalized. Be sure and research your potential instructors, as there are many horror stories about instructors that just want to showcase and sell their artwork and are hostile or demeaning to the students. Some are good instructors but NOT good artists, and some are good artists but NOT good instructors. Choose your workshop wisely! I want to thank each one of you so much for your assistance and cooperation this past year for Shows, paint-outs, and events! I was overwhelmed and pleased to see such good participation. This meant a lot to me as it indicated that the cooperation and working togetherness is "still alive and well" and that the Artists' Guild has the potential for much success. The Guild is an important integral part of the county. We promote the arts; and we unite the artists to offer opportunities for sales, learning, and sharing. We are under the umbrella of the Arts Council of Calvert County. Where else could

you get all of the above for \$25/yr membership? 2007 will be a GREAT YEAR!!

On Sunday, **November 19, 2006** we'll hold the Calvert Artists' Guild Annual Meeting & Program, **at the Phillips House, Prince Frederick, MD starting at 2pm**. Bring finger foods. During the business meeting we will hold elections and discuss the events planned for 2007. Prior to the business meeting we will have a program about art therapy presented by Vickey Spore.

The Phillips House is in Prince Frederick behind the OLD P.F. Library (on Duke Street). Go into the old Library parking lot behind the library and there is a roadway to the meeting location with a sign "Phillips House" and there will be an Artists' Guild sign.

Vickey Spore has been using art as a modality and therapeutic means for the past three years. Ms. Spore is a Graphic Designer/Print Production Manager, and has worked in Iowa, Nebraska, Missouri, Texas and Maryland in the graphics field for nearly three decades. She has worked in Free-lance - Commercial Art for twenty years while managing at several printing companies and advertising agencies in their print production management depts, and assisting the graphic design teams. She has worked with Computer Graphics since 1989. In the past 3 years she has explored Art Therapy while volunteering for the bereaved children's' support groups and camps with Hospice of St. Mary's, and has taught private art instruction to young children. She has worked with a certified Art Therapist for the past 3 years for her own support and usage for healing from life changes and enhancing creativity to begin to paint again. She has won state awards and national recognition for commercial art designs done in Texas. While living in Houston, she attained additional opportunity in directing with committee the first Texas Graphic Excellence Awards Program. Three years later, she won the "Samuel Bangs Award" for her piece-"The Texas Legacy", the best historical graphic piece in the state. She has also won awards from the Houston Advertising Federation competition. And worked with freelance graphic design and other positions in the graphics industry. She is a graduate of Texas State University, in San Marcos, Texas with a BFA degree in Commercial Art; has attained continued education in Computer Graphic studies with Houston Community College.
