As the Guild nears its 30th Anniversary in 2008, I have thought about the growth and changes made in the Artists' Guild. Some may like change, others may not, but in order to stay solvent and to keep members we have to change to fit the needs and causes. I began reminiscing and listed a few. - * Back in the earlier years our meetings were held on the 2nd Wed. night, 7-9 p.m. at the P.F. Library. We changed to Saturdays/Sundays because of weeknight conflicts, work/jobs, location availability, & night driving.

Calvert Artists' Guild May Multi-media Show & Awards

Calling all artists to mark your calendars for Saturday and Sunday, May 5 and 6, 2007, 10-4, for the annual May "CAG Multi-Media May Show" at Annmarie Garden. We will again feature ribbons and monetary awards to be presented at the Reception on May 5th. The judge for awards is Carolyn Egeli, a long time teacher and prominent portrait artist. We toured her gallery in 2006 and saw her completed works and works in progress. Our member artists in all mediums are encouraged to join in this special show. We would like to see fiber work, jewelry, sculpture, glass, batik, weaving, ceramics, as well as paintings. A reception will be held on Saturday, May 5th from 2pm to 4pm to present awards and the scholarship winner. The entry fee for CAG members is \$25.00 and \$35.00 fee for nonmembers. Exhibiting artists are asked to sign up to sit the gallery for a two-hour shift on Saturday or Sunday. Registrations are to be postmarked by April 28th, no registrations will be accepted after May 1st. Artwork should be dropped off at Annmarie Garden on Friday. May 4th, 2007, from 10am to 1pm. Volunteers are needed to help hang the show. The same rules apply as per the March 2007 show. If you are a new exhibitor at Annmarie Garden you are required to submit a photo. postcard, or notecard of the type of artwork to be shown along with the registration form. (Form follows in newsletter) Annmarie Garden will keep a file of all artists and their artwork samples for future reference. This means you only have to submit the initial photo and for future shows, you state "photo on file" on your registration form. You do not have to resubmit a new photo for every show. If you submitted your sample in 2006, you do not need to resubmit for 2007. The only exception would be if you change media-(i.e. from oil paintings to jewelry, ceramics to paintings, etc.). The Guild will submit all registrations and representative samples of artwork to Annmarie Garden. Only artists with over \$125 in sales will be charged 15% commission for AM Garden & fees. 


Scholarship Award

Glenn Linton graduated from Old Dominion University with a B.S. degree in art education. He has had his work displayed in various galleries including the Chrysler Museum. The last seven years he has been giving seminars in drawing to high school art teachers and college professors. Glenn recently retired after thirtyone years teaching art in Accomack County. He is devoting his retirement years to sculpting, writing and illustrating children's books.

Glenn's first book Buster B. Bluecrab went on the market in January 2005. This book has taken him on book signing tours as far away as Georgia. Through his children's books he will continue to share his love of art and teaching with generations to come.

Glenn has been on television several times. WBOC -TV won a National award with a segment they did on Glenn's stone sculpting.

Calvert Artists' Guild Library Show May 14 - June 30, 2007

The Guild along with the Lexington Park Library will host an art show from May 14 - June 30, 2007. The show will be held in the Lexington Park Library in Lexington Park, Maryland in their new gallery space. The library will provide the following for us: postcards, advertising, a reception as well as display space. Candy Cummings is in charge of the gallery and will hang the show for us. At this time only 2-D work can be displayed, however, we are working with the library to allow artists to display small 3-D works. When we find out about the 3-D work we will notify you by email. The following is a list of rules and information for the show.

- 1. No fees or commissions are charged by the library but donations are accepted.
- 2. 2-D artwork must be framed and wired in the back for hanging.
- 3. Subject matter and content of all artwork on display must be appropriate for viewing by library-visiting adults and children.

- 4. The Gallery space is 40 feet long by 6 feet high and can hold 20 - 30 paintings.
- 5. Since gallery space is limited each artist should plan on submitting only 2 pieces of artwork. If the artwork is large, plan on submitting only one piece. (Subject to # of artists entered) 6. Artwork must be available for duration of show (11/2

months).

- 7. All work must have 2 cards with the following information on them: title, medium, price, name of artist, contact information (phone number and/or email address). The artist is responsible for all sales. The library will not collect any fees. One card must be attached to the back of the artwork and one card will be placed beside the hung work.
- 8. For artists who are concerned about leaving their work in a public space; the library will put security labels on their work. These labels will be provided by the library. The gallery space is across from the librarian's station and will be monitored.
- 9. All artists must provide a short biography, a brief description of the style and medium of the art, along with an electronic copy in JPEG format of the artwork you plan to submit. This information will be used to create a brochure for the show. Please submit this to Maria Fleming at:

fleminamp@verizon.net. The deadline for submitting the photos is May 11, 2007. If you only have photographs or slides please contact Maria to set up a date and time to scan them.

- 10. Artwork may dropped off at the Lexington Park Library from Friday, May 11, between 9-5; until 9:00 am. Monday, May 14, 2007
- 11. If you would like to have invitational postcards sent to your mailing list, please provide the labels to the library when you drop off your work. The library will furnish postcards and mailing.
