Calvert Artists' Guild May Multi-media Awards Show

Calling all artists to mark your calendars for Saturday and Sunday, May 3 and 4, 2008, 10-4, for the annual May "CAG Multi-Media Awards Show" at Annmarie Garden. We will again feature ribbons and monetary awards to be presented at the Reception on May 3rd. The judge for awards is Kay Sandler. New Rules: Artwork must have been completed within last two years. Artwork must not have won an award in a previous CAG Show. Artists in all mediums are encouraged to join in this special show. We would like to see fiber work, jewelry, sculpture, glass, batik, weaving, ceramics, as well as paintings. A reception will be held on Saturday, May 3rd from 2pm to 4pm to present awards and the scholarship winner. The entry fee for CAG members is \$25.00 and \$35.00 fee for non-members. Exhibiting artists are asked to sign up to sit the gallery for a two-hour shift on Saturday or Sunday. Registrations are to be postmarked by April 25th, no registrations will be accepted after April **28th**. Artwork should be dropped off at Annmarie Garden on Friday, May 2, 2008, from 10am to 1pm. Volunteers are needed to help hang the show. The same rules apply as per the March 2008 show. If you are a new exhibitor at Annmarie Garden you are required to submit a photo, postcard, or notecard of the type of artwork to be shown attached with the entry form. (Form follows in newsletter) Annmarie Garden will keep a file of all artists and their artwork samples for future reference. This means you only have to submit the initial photo and for future shows, you state "photo on file" on vour registration form. You do not have to resubmit a new photo for every show. If you submitted your sample in 2007, you do not need to resubmit for 2008. The only exception would be if you change media—(i.e. from oil paintings to jewelry, ceramics to paintings, etc.). The Guild will submit all registrations and representative samples of artwork to Annmarie Garden. Only artists with over \$125 in sales will be charged 15% commission for AM Garden & fees. 

Featured Member

Not all members of the Calvert Artist Guild are artists themselves. **Barbara Fetterhoff** shares some Guild history along with how she became involved.

In December 2000, then-Guild-President, Shonne Farrell, approached the Calvert County (now the Patuxent River) branch of the AAUW (American Association of University Women) to help re-establish the Calvert Artists' Guild. CAG had been started in 1978 by Carolyn Aamot, Gerry Wood, and Nancy Callahan to promote the appreciation and practice of the fine arts in Calvert County, but had faltered in more recent years.

It was agreed AAUW would co-sponsor with CAG a Women's Art Show during Women's History Month in 2001. Then Shonne moved away and Gerry Wood became acting president. CAG and AAUW went ahead with the joint art show March 10-11 – AAUW hosted a reception and held a raffle of two paintings by Jeanne Hawkins Rogers to raise money for the AAUW Educational Foundation. This was repeated in 2002, featuring a fine art painting by Gerry Wood and in 2003 with a painting by Millie DeMent.

In 2000, Barbara was president of the AAUW branch and joined CAG, while Gerry and Eileen Baca joined AAUW. "I have enjoyed my membership and have bought a dozen or so works of art in the meantime, now hanging in our apartment," notes Barbara. "No, I am not an artist myself – I guess I am an art patron." Barbara served as secretary for the Calvert Artists' Guild in 2004 when Marge King was president and has also helped to organize CAG events held in the Asbury-Solomons clubhouse.

The women's creativity art shows continued until the men complained and it was agreed to change the emphasis after the 2003 event. "But," says Barbara, "it

was a pleasure to help the Artists' Guild to become such a successful organization for artists in Southern Maryland!"
