

The Rocking Tie-Dye Review

On January 21, 2013 there was a rocking workshop held at the Mount Hope Community Center in Sunderland, MD with the main act being Mike and Virginia Richardson of "Yes, Virginia Creations"! Virginia started the show with a bouncy rendition of "Tie-Dye Spiral" and finished with a rousing "Tie-Dye a Heart". Several other hopping numbers were thrown in between, such as the well-received "Polka Dots All Over" blues and the more sedate "Tie-Dye a Peace Sign" Tie-Dye Polka!







Following Virginia's performance Mike took center stage with his Amazing Technicolor Dye Bin and started slinging dyes on to the shirts with wild abandon! Bottles were flying in and out of the storage bins while Mike played the color wheel like the seasoned pro that he is. The dye flowed and the colors bloomed as we watched and learned from the Master!

With the main acts complete, the audience was compelled to join in and then there was a spirited free-for-all jam session where we all proceeded to let our creativity flow just as fast as the dye. Hearts, Peace Signs, Stripes, and rocking free form designs were the result. Everyone left the show with several self-made mementos of the show. 


No makeup classes will be offered except if classes are cancelled due to inclement weather.



Tricks of the Trade

How To Make BLACK

There are many complimentary colors when mixed together can create a BLACK. Remember, colors are always reflective and black directly from the tube can be too intense or dull. So you can create a CHROMATIC BLACK which is an illusion of black by mixing reds and greens or blues and reds.



Some examples are:

Alizarin Crimson with Thalo Green

Ultramarine Blue with Burnt Sienna

Burnt Umber with Ultramarine Blue
