



STAINED GLASS WORKSHOP

Saturday, June 25, 2016 10:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Mt. Hope Community Center 104 Pushaw Station Road, Sunderland, MD 20689



Ray and Phyllis Noble have been involved with glass art for the past 10 years. It started with a stained glass class and has evolved to fused glass and jewelry. The workshop class on June 25th will be held at Mt. Hope Community Center and will cost \$35/person. Each student is expected to complete a 6" X 6" stained glass piece from a selection of glass patterns that will be made available. The Tiffany style will be taught in which each piece of glass is wrapped in copper foil and the various pieces soldered together.

All glass and tools will be provided at no extra cost. The maximum number of students is 8. Everyone must wear protective eye gear and wear closed toe shoes. Since glass cuts, those taking anticoagulant drugs (aspirin, warfarin, etc) must use extreme caution. If you have a soldering iron or other glass tools, please feel free to bring them.

We look forward to this exciting workshop.
